


72nd ANNUAL TEXAS TOUR

This year’s tour has been designed to take time driving our vehicles (which is the primary purpose of a group tour) and to visit interesting sights outside of the city of Waco, while maximizing the available time. Judging will occur concurrent with other activities to allow more time for touring and sightseeing.

We have planned our tours and routes so that there is sufficient time for all activities without being rushed. None of our routes will ever require a speed greater than 45 miles per hour. Try it at this speed and you will be surprised at what you will **SEE** that you never saw before. We want to honor the history of the 1st Texas Tour that began in Waco in 1954, so we are “Turning Back the Clock” to honor the tradition of a leisurely tour on two-lane roads.

We ask that you bring with you or encourage a registration to be submitted by one or more people who have never before attended a Texas Tour - - and who are younger than you are. We encourage you to do this to ensure the continued success of the Texas Tour for future generations.

There are too many interesting places and sights within Waco to include in a two-day tour. However, we invite you to arrive early on Thursday and follow our recommendations for Early Bird adventures and sightseeing before the official start of the planned events. We will provide guidance for places to visit, places to eat lunch, photo destinations, and interesting finds in Waco, so you can meet up with friends and have a relaxing day on your own visiting destinations that interest you.

The planned tour events begin Thursday evening at 5:30pm with a casual welcome dinner in the picturesque courtyard pavilion at the hotel. This has historically been a very important time for renewing acquaintances with friends from past tours and for making friends with new people attending. Please try to arrive in time for this event starting around 5:30pm.

This year, the car judging will occur in conjunction with the Friday driving tour. The Friday tour includes a peaceful drive to a community that in many respects lives off the land reminiscent of times prior to industrialization, where crops are grown and used by the community, and artisans still perform their crafts of woodworking, pottery, leather work, fiber crafts, and blacksmithing, by hand. The tour vehicles will park in a grassy area for the judging. While the judging tasks place, the attendees have an opportunity to visit the artisans' shops, the chocolate shop, the coffee shop, and others where everything is produced at this location, and will be served a great barbeque lunch. Then we are headed on a leisurely drive to Hillsboro for a destination visit, and then back to the hotel. Friday concludes with dinner and entertainment in the banquet room at the hotel.

Saturday's tour will take us along a route to the little town of West. We will join up for a short time with a local antique car show to allow a chance for the spectators to see our vehicles from the Texas Tour, while we have a chance to meet the locals and see their car show. After that, we will stop in town to give attendees the opportunity to visit a great historical museum, quaint shops, and enjoy lunch in the local restaurants. We will then depart on a trip through the less traveled roads to a very unique and mostly unknown private museum and auto-related collection with one of the largest and most unique sign collections anywhere. We promise, you don't want to miss this. After all this, we will make a short return trip back to the hotel. Saturday concludes with dinner and entertainment in the banquet room at the hotel, followed by awarding of the Texas Tour "Class Judging", "Revolving Trophies" and other special awards. This would be the ideal time for you to present yourself in vintage attire for recognition during the dinner.

We wrap up on Sunday morning with a leisurely breakfast in the hotel and departure for home. The Texas Tour business meeting will follow breakfast and be conducted in the Board Room at the hotel. Each club in the tour rotation should be represented by at least one individual at this business session. Any participant in the tour who is a member of a club that is not already in the rotation for hosting the Texas Tour, may attend this meeting, and consider making a campaign for their own club to join the rotation and host a Texas Tour in the future.
